



1. India Day 2019 will be held at SMU McFarlin Auditorium, Dallas, Texas on Saturday, February 9th, 2019.
2. Registration will open December 21st, 2018 and close January 12th, 2019. Register your team at the [registration portal](#), before January 12th, 2019.
3. Choreographers must FULLY complete the Entry Forms including membership or transaction ID for paid membership. Our preference is transaction ID. But Membership number is also acceptable.
4. All entries should reach us through our [registration portal](#). Any other means such as verbal, email or phone entries will not be accepted.
5. All India Day participants including Choreographers, assistants and performers, must be IANT members at the time of registration and at the time of the program.
6. Previous members can find their Membership number printed on address portion of Bharati Magazine.
7. All Participants can renew or apply for membership at <http://www.iant.org>. Registration will be considered incomplete, if proof of valid membership is not available on the entry form.
8. Sending an entry form is not an automatic acceptance to perform at India Day. Entries will be confirmed by India Day committee upon verification of data.
9. Solo performances will not be accepted. Each performance must have a minimum 10 participants with a maximum of 20 participants including choreographers and assistants.
10. Each performance can have a single Choreographer and an assistant if needed; An additional assistant can be added to the team, if there are more than 12 participants in a performance.
11. No performer will be allowed to participate in more than one performance.
12. Minimum age to participate is Six (6) years at the time of submission.
13. Due to the nature of the program, no live vocal or music performances will be accepted. Only pre-recorded audio recordings will be accepted as background music for the performance.
14. Each performance cannot exceed 4 minutes 30 seconds
15. Repetition of songs in performances is not allowed. Similar performances will be selected on 'First-Come-First served' basis.
16. We encourage themes that are fast paced Folk, Regional, Patriotic, Semi-classical and Movie song performances.
17. Dance schools submitting multiple entries must have each performance submitted in a different theme.
18. Performers are not allowed to wear glass accessories or use props that can shatter, break or leave residue on the floor, e.g. trinkets, jewelry that can break easily. No stickers, tapes or markers on stage.
19. All participants, including Choreographers and their assistant(s) will be given complimentary non-transferrable wristband/entry-pass to attend India Day. Their complimentary seats will be reserved in a particular section.
20. All Participants who want to sit outside of their reserved section before/after their performance, must buy tickets



21. All participants will be provided complimentary beverages and snacks after their performance.
22. All participants must report to the back-stage coordinator on Saturday, Feb 9th, 2019 at SMU McFarlin Auditorium by their specified reporting time
23. For a smooth flow of the INDIA DAY program, your cooperation is highly appreciated.
24. SMU is going to have PAID PARKING and carpooling is encouraged.
25. IANT's decision will be deemed final in all contingency situations.
